



### Your Multi-buntu DVD

The DVD included with this issue lets you sample a selection of the most popular Ubuntu variants. Boot the disk to a Live version of Ubuntu 9.04 "Jaunty Jackalope," or install a permanent version of Jaunty on your hard drive.

When you are ready for a taste of some other flavors, double-click the VirtualBox icon on your Ubuntu desktop to launch any of the following:

- **Kubuntu:** Ubuntu for the KDE desktop.
- **Xubuntu:** small and light on resources – optimized for legacy hardware.
- **Easy Peasy:** tooled for netbook systems.

Also included on this DVD is a bootable disc image of Ubuntu Studio – an Ubuntu alternative for high-end audio recording studios and multimedia configurations.
